## Activities:

Battery D, First Field Artillery was organized in compliance with the proclamation of the President of the United States, dated July 3, 1917.\*\*\*\* Less than one month after orders were received to recruit the company to full war strength, Battery D was mustered into Federal Service. New recruits were particularly eager to enlist in the artillery branch of service as they were assured of being sent to France after a period of Training. The length of time required for training varied somewhat and Battery D did not leave for France Until August 1918\*\*\*\*. After having been mustered into Federal Service, the unit was stationed at the State Armory in San Diego. Captain J. C. Schindler began their training with a hike, marching his men "up the hill and down again". This exercise was followed by a drill. The troops were gradually put through all military requirements of drill and field maneuvers.
