Activities

The Sanitary Detachment 7th Infantry Regiment was organized in Riverie June 1, 1901. Hajor William W. Robles was the first commanding officer or the unit. Other Majors of the detachment were Francis M. Bruner.
Paul Allen Adams, Charles W. Decker, Howard W. Seagar and Frank C. Wiser.
Major Wiser commanded the unit during the time it was in Federal Ser-

vice at the Mexican Border June 29, 1916 to November 11, 1916.

The following year April 5, 1917, the Sanitary Detachment as a part of the Seventh Infantry Regiment was mustered into Federal Service for duty during the World War. The Regiment was on guard duty at various industries that were essential in war time. In September the Regiment was assembled at Camp Kearney and on October 14, 1917, Sanitary Detachment Seventh Infantry Regiment and Sanitary Detachment Second Infantry Regiment was consolidated and designated Medical Detachment 180th Infantry Regiment.
