

NATIONAL GUARD OF CALIFORNIA.

The National Guard of California, as at present constituted, consists of 61 companies of infantry and artillery, 4 troops cavalry, 1 cadet company, and 3 signal corps—organized into 9 regiments and 4 unattached companies, 3 brigades, and 1 division, with a total strength of 384 officers and 3,710 enlisted men.

In addition to the above mentioned force, there is a battalion of 4 companies of naval militia, with headquarters at San Francisco. It has a total strength of 23 officers and 239 seamen. Enrolled militia, 197,072. Total appropriations by the State for the two years ending June 30, 1895, \$330,100.
