Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 July 1959 as Battery D, 1st Rocket Howitzer Battalion, 144th Artillery, an element of the 40th Armored Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1963 as Battery C, 1st Battalion, 144th Artillery

Consolidated 29 January 1965 with the 1114th Transportation Company (organized and Federally recognized 4 March 1967 at San Luis Obispo), and consolidated unit designated as the 1498th Transportation Company; concurrently, relieved from assignment to the 40th Armored Division
