A	June 26, 1916	Troop A of Bakersfield entrained at Sacramento for Nogales, Arizona, June 28, 1916. Arrived at Camp Stephen Little, Nogales, Arizona, July second. Went on Border Patrol at Nogales July fifteenth. Dismounted drill morning and afternoon. Non-commissioned officers school duty. During month of August, performed outpost duty on hill south of Squadron camp every fifth day. During month of September performed same duties as in month of August. In Camp at Nogales October first to fourth. October fifth left camp on practice march with First Provisional Regiment of Cavalry. Camped at Huachuca October fifteenth to twenty-second. Target and battle practice and Squadron drill. Returned to Nogales Oct. twenty-fifth. Entrained for Los Angeles October twenty-sixth. Arrived October twenty-eighth. B	June 26, 1916	Troop B entrained at Sacramento for Nogales, Arizona, June 28, 1916. Arrived at Camp Stephen Little, Nogales, Arizona, July 2. On border patrol south of Nogales July fifteenth to end of month. Also performed regular drills and attended school. Performed outpost duty south of camp during month of August every fifth day. September duties same as in August. Joined with First Provisional Regiment of Cavalry in practice march to Huachuca, October fifth. Camped at Huachuca October fifteenth to October twenty-second. Squadron drill, target and battle practice. Returned to Camp Stephen Little, arriving there October twenty-fifth. Entrained for Los Angeles October twenty-sixth. Arrived at Los Angeles October twenty-eighth. In camp at Los Angeles until mustered out, then returned to home station at Sacramento.	Henry H. Sydenham, Captain	Nov. 17, 1916

C	June 26, 1916	<p>Troop C of Salinas assembled at their armory pursuant to orders and proceeded to Sacramento where they were mustered into the service of the United States June 26, 1916. June twenty-eighth entrained for Nogales, Arizona. July second arrived at Nogales and encamped at Camp Stephen Little. On border patrol duty and outpost duty, regular drills and school July fifteenth to August thirty-first. September first to ninth routine camp duties, September tenth marched to Huachuca for target and rifle practice. In camp at Garden Canyon near Huachuca September fifteenth to September thirtieth. Marched from Huachuca to Camp Stephen Little October first to fifth. Performed routine camp duties at camp until October twenty-fifth. Entrained at Nogales October twenty-sixth. Arrived at Los Angeles October twenty-eighth and established camp at Exposition Park, Los Angeles. Performed routine camp duties there until November seventeenth when Troop was mustered out of Federal Service and returned to home station.</p>	Edward J. Hardy, Captain	Nov. 17, 1916

D	June 27, 1916	<p>Troop D of Los Angeles was mustered into the service of the United States for duty on the Mexican Border Nov. 27, 1916. Arrived at Nogales, Arizona, July second. Established camp at Camp Stephen Little and performed ordinary routine duties until July fifteenth. Detailed on border patrol duty July fifteenth to August first. On outpost duty near Nogales August first to thirty-first. Also attended drills and school for Non-commission officers. September first to September ninth performed routine camp duties. September tenth proceeded toward Fort Huachuca. In camp at Garden Canyon near Huachuca September fifteenth to September thirtieth where Troop engaged in target and rifle practice. Returned to Nogales October fifth. Routine and camp duties at camp Stephen Little near Nogales until October twenty-fifth. Entrained October twenty-sixth. Arrived at Los Angeles October twenty-eighth. In camp at Exposition Park, Los Angeles, where Troop performed routine duties until November seventeenth when troop was mustered out of Federal Service.</p>	James Gunn, Captain	Nov. 17, 1916
