History Of Camp San Luis Obispo

When the California Legislature provided for the formation of the California Militia in 1850, it was the start of a heritage that would lead the California National Guard to be one of the finest military organizations in the country. Before Camp Merriam was established as a Guard training site just north of San Luis Obispo in 1929, military exercises were carried out at state parks, Federal military installations and ranches throughout the state.

In 1940 the U.S. Army leased Camp Merriam and re-named it Camp San Luis Obispo. In 1946 CSLO was returned to the State of California, along with an additional 10,500 acres which included the Salinas Dam, a supplemental source of water for CSLO. The cantonment area not previously owned by the State, including all improvements on both sides of the highway, was ceded to the state in lieu of restoration.

In following years CSLO became the home of the United States Property and Fiscal Office for California and a training site for the 40th and 49th Infantry Divisions. From that time the California Military Academy was established and various other government and military organizations initiated training programs at the still blossoming Home of the California National Guard.

The demand for National Guard and Army training areas has risen dramatically since the closure in 1970 of Federal installations at Camp Roberts and Fort Irwin. Accordingly, Camp San Luis Obispo, Training Center for the California National Guard, will continue to grow as a major asset to the Armed Forces on the West Coast and as a proud tradition in the historical annals of the State of California.

HISTORY OF CMA

It was the summer of 1950 and junior officers in the California National Guard were fast becoming a rare commodity.

Responding to the situation at hand, Maj. Gen. C.D. O'Sullivan, then commanding general of the 49th Division, conceived a program that would remedy the deficiency. He sought and received authorization from the Department of the Army to establish an "Officer Candidate School" outside of the existing system.

The school, offering commission opportunity to enlisted persons already in the California National Guard, immediately came under close scrutiny from all quarters.

The program proved successful and began to expand its format to provide the best possible instruction.

Although the school continued to grow in size and importance, it had no suitable facilities for academic training. In 1961, Camp San Luis Obispo was able to accomodate the school. Two years later, the name was changed and the California Military Academy (CMA) had found a home.

During 1981, the school's 31st year, Camp Roberts was utilized for training of CMA Cadets as a temporary Move.

The course of instruction at CMA parallels that of the Infantry School at Fort Benning, Georgia, providing solid training in the basic skills and capabilities required of a junior officer.


The program comes under continuing observation and evaluation, and is comparable to the specialized officer candidate school within the active Army.
